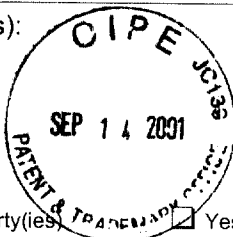

WHEREAS, I verily believe myself to be the original, first and sole inventor of the invention set forth in said application for Letters Patent; and




