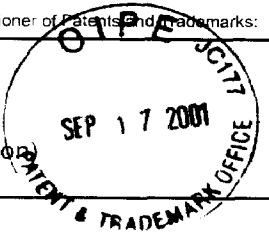

ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, David E. Bryan, of P.O. Box 792, Buchanan, Virginia 24066 and Carl M. Dudding of 3412 Craig Creek Road, Eagle Rock, Virginia 24085 (hereinafter "Assignors"), have invented certain new and useful improvements in a CENTRIFUGAL PELLET DRYER for which an application for United States Letters Patent, was filed on May 18, 2001, and assigned U.S. Serial No. 09/861,497 ;
