ASSIGNMENT OF INVENTIONS AND COMPANY INFORMATION AGREEMENT

In consideration of my employment by Texas Instruments (Philippines), Incorporated, hereinafter referred to as TIPI, which term as used in this agreement includes any parent or subsidiary thereof or any subsidiary of any parent thereof, I hereby agree as follow:

ASSIGNMENT OF INVENTIONS

A. I agree to disclose promptly, completely, and in writing to TIPI and I hereby assign and agree to assign and bind my heirs, executors, or administrators to assign to TIPI or its designee, its assigns, successors or legal representatives, any and all inventions, processes, diagrams, methods, apparatus, or any improvements (all hereinafter collectively called "inventions") whatsoever, discovered, conceived, and/or developed, either individually or jointly with others, during the course of my employment with TIPI, or using TIPI'S time, data, facilities and/or materials, provided the subject matter is one within a field of interest of TIPI. My obligations under this paragraph apply without regard to whether an idea for an invention or a solution to a problem occurs to me on the job, at home, or elsewhere. I further agree that all such inventions are TIPI'S exclusive property, whether or not patent applications are filed thereon.

B. Subject matter within a field of interest to TIPI includes any field of interest that has been worked on by TIPI in the past, in which there is work in progress at TIPI at the date of or during my employment with TIPI and projects or other operations at TIPI planned for the future. It is expressly understood that this agreement does not apply to any of my patents or patent applications field or based on inventions made prior to my employment with TIPI or to matters (other than matters within a field of interest of TIPI) which are exclusively of personal interest.

C. I shall assist TIPI at any time during or after my employment is terminated, at TIPI expense, in the preparation, execution, and delivery of any disclosures, patent applications, or papers within the scope and intent of this agreement required to obtain patent in this or other countries and in connection with such other proceedings as may be necessary to vest title thereto in TIPI, its assigns, successors, or legal representatives. If such assistance takes place after my employment is terminated, I shall be paid by TIPI at a reasonable rate for any time that I actually spend in such work at TIPI'S request.

COMPANY INFORMATION

A. I recognize that my position with TIPI is one of highest trust and confidence by reason of my access to and contact with the trade secrets and confidential and proprietary business information of TIPI. I shall use my best efforts and exercise utmost diligence to protect and safeguard the trade secrets and confidential or proprietary information of TIPI.

B. Except as may be required by TIPI in connection with and during my employment with TIPI or with the express written permission of TIPI, I shall not, either during my employment with TIPI or thereafter, directly or indirectly, use for my own benefit or for the benefit of another, or disclose to another, any trade secret or confidential or proprietary information (whether or not acquired, learned, obtained or developed by myself alone or in conjunction with others) of TIPI, its customers, contractors, or of others with which TIPI has a business relationship.

C. I further agree that all memoranda, notes, records, drawings, or other documents made or compiled by me or made available to me while employed by TIPI concerning any process, apparatus, or products manufactured, used, developed, investigated, or considered by TIPI or concerning any other TIPI activity shall be the property of TIPI and shall be delivered to TIPI upon termination of my employment or at any other time upon request.

D. At the request of TIPI, I will furnish a copy hereof to any employer by whom I should propose to be employed within 12 months after termination of my employment with TIPI. In the event I should propose to be self-employed (which term shall include acting as an employee of any company of which I shall have over 5 percent ownership or as an officer of any company) within such 12 month period, at the request of TIPI, I shall furnish a copy hereof to any customer I or such company shall propose to serve with any product or service produced or provided by TIPI. In the event of my failure so to do, TIPI may so furnish copies hereof.

III

MISCELLANEOUS

A. Nothing contained in this agreement shall be construed as impairing my right or the right of TIPI to terminate employment hereunder.

B. My obligations under this agreement shall continue whether or not my employment with TIPI shall be terminated voluntarily or involuntarily, with or without cause.

C. This agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of TIPI, its successors in business and upon me, my heirs, executors, and administrators.

D. This agreement replaces all previous agreements relating to the same or similar matters which I may have entered into with TIPI with respect to my present and any future period of employment by TIPI. This agreement may not be modified in any respect by any verbal statement, representation or agreement made by any other employee of TIPI, or by a written document signed by any employee of TIPI other than an officer thereof.

E. If any portion or provision of this agreement is held invalid unenforceable, this shall not affect the validity and enforceability of the remainder of the agreement.

F. The law of the Philippines will govern the interpretation, validity, and effect of this agreement without regard to the place of execution of the place of performance thereof.

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F. The law of the Philippines will govern the interpretation, validity, and effect of this agreement without regard to the place of execution of the place of performance thereof.




