### Supported Polymeric Liquid Membrane Sale Agreement

This Agreement is effective January 25, 2001 (the "Effective Date") and is by and between:

Pharmacia Corporation, a Delaware corporation having an office at 800 North Lindbergh Blvd., St. Louis, MO 63167 ("Pharmacia") and

Spectrum Laboratories, Inc. a Delaware corporation with offices at 23022 La Cadena, Laguna Hills, CA 92653 ("Spectrum").

In consideration of the mutual covenants and payments described below, Pharmacia agrees to assign certain patent rights and technology to Spectrum.

#### 1. Definitions

1.01 The following terms shall have the indicated meanings.

1.02 Patent Rights means those patents and patent applications listed in Attachment A, which is incorporated by reference, together with all continuations, divisionals, continuations-in-part and extensions.

1.03 Technology means the technical information which relates to supported polymeric liquid membranes which is contained in the technical reports listed in Attachment B, which is incorporated by reference.

#### 2. Assignments and Reservation of Rights

2.01 Pharmacia agrees to assign to Spectrum the Patent Rights, subject to the reserved rights provided for below.

2.02 Pharmacia agrees to assign to Spectrum the Technology, subject to the reserved rights provided for below.

2.03 Spectrum shall be responsible for preparing and recording any and all documents necessary for perfecting or recording the transfer of ownership of the Patent Rights in any applicable patent offices. Pharmacia shall cooperate by providing such information as may be reasonably requested by Spectrum and by executing such documents.

2.04 Pharmacia reserves for itself and for its subsidiary, Monsanto Company, a Delaware corporation, also with offices at 800 North Lindbergh Blvd., St. Louis, MO 63167, a nonexclusive, worldwide, paid up license under the Patent Rights and under the Technology for research, development and production of materials
