UNITED STATES PATENT ASSIGNMENT




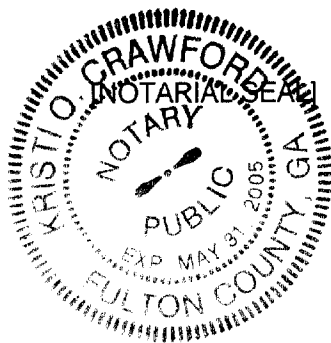
