

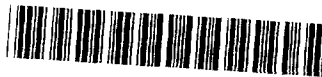

## ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, I, DONALD F. KLUS, a citizen of the United States of America residing at 11890 S.W. North Dakota Street, Tigard, Oregon 97223, have invented certain new and useful improvements in "Fire Door Components and Fire Doors Comprising the Components", for which an application for Letters Patent of the United States was filed on July 6, 2001, and accorded Serial No. 09/899,542; and
