ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, Chunlin TAO, Beverly Hills, California and Chanjun YU, Pasadena, California have invented certain new and useful improvements in and have filed an application for a United States patent entitled: **TARGET ANALYTE DETECTION USING ASYMMETRICAL SELF-ASSEMBLED MONOLAYERS** bearing Serial No. 09/847,113 filed May 1, 2001, disclosing and identifying the invention; and

applications for reissuance of any said patents; (e) for interference or other priority proceedings involving said invention; and (f) for legal proceedings involving said invention and any applications therefor and any patents granted thereon, including without limitation opposition proceedings, cancellation proceedings, priority contests, public use proceedings, infringement actions and court actions; provided, however, that the expense incurred by said Inventor in providing such cooperation shall be paid for by said Assignee.

3. The terms and covenants of this assignment shall inure to the benefit of said Assignee, its successors, assigns and other legal representatives, and shall be binding upon said Inventors, their heirs, legal representatives and assigns.
