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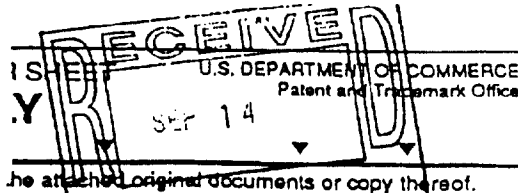

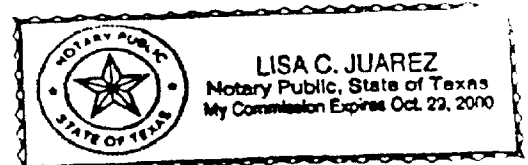

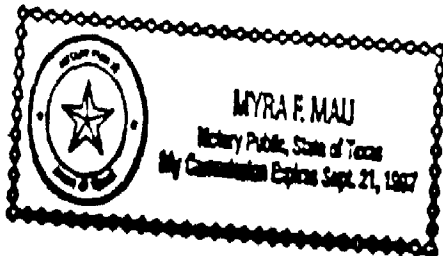

This is a decision on the request for reconsideration filed November 17, 1998 of the dismissal of petition filed December 09, 1997 to correct inventorship under 37 CFR 1.324.

In response to the Examiner's dismissal of the petition to correct inventorship rendered on April 02, 1998, the attorney of record has submitted sworn affidavits from Francis Forsberg and Stephen M. LeBlond attesting to the contributions they made to US Patent No. 5669221. In the

case of Mr. Forsberg his affidavit states in part that he was instrumental in conceiving the following features that were claimed (emphasis added) in US Patent No. 5669221:

- ☐ Utilizing a continuously circulating system
- ☐ adding handles for transportation
- ☐ utilizing particle generators for airflow

In the case of Mr. Stephen M. LeBleu his affidavit states in part that he was instrumental in conceiving the following features that were claimed (emphasis added) in US Patent No. 5669221:

- ☐ The process of enhancing water production through condensation from a refrigeration process with low temperature gases through various coils and fans.
- ☐ The application of ultraviolet light to water condensed in a reservoir and recirculation of the reservoir water through ultraviolet light to supply sufficient radiation energy to kill adventitious bacteria and viruses.

Mr Terry LeBleu one of the originally named inventors had signed declarations declaring that Mr. Francis Forsberg and Mr. Stephen M. LeBleu where indeed co- inventors.

It should be mentioned that on December 12, 1998 Mr Terry LeBleu filed papers in the Patent Office stating in part that he alone was the inventor of the subject matter in Serial No. 08/629,305 now US Patent 5669221.


