WHEREAS, we, Brian Storrie and Maria Tarrago-Trani, (hereinafter called assignors) have invented certain new and useful improvements in B/B-LIKE FRAGMENT TARGETING FOR THE PURPOSE OF PHOTODYNAMIC THERAPY AND MEDICAL IMAGING, for which a United States Letters Patent application No. 09/894,896 was filed on June 29, 2001; and
