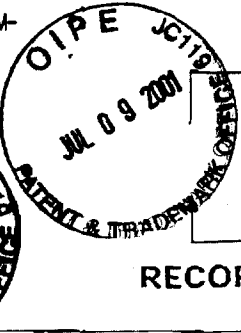



This action came on regularly for trial on 9 MARCH 2001, in Department 310 of the Superior Court, the Honorable RICARDO A. TORRES, Judge Presiding; the plaintiff appearing by attorney(s) HOWARD E. KING and STEPHEN D. ROTHSCHILD of KING, PURTICH, HOLMES, PATERNO and BERLINER, L.L.P.,

and the defendant PAYSTATION AMERICA, successor in interest for DIRECT EXPRESS, appearing by attorney(s) JOSEPH P. QUINBY of ARTER & HADDEN,

and defendant LOUIS J. KROUSE appearing by attorney STEVEN J. REVITZ of RAISKIN & REVITZ.

A Jury of TWELVE persons was regularly impaneled and acknowledged and agreed to try the cause. Witnesses were sworn and testified. 

KROUSE and PayStation America, Inc., as successor- in-interest to Direct Express, LLC, jointly and severally, in the sum of \$500,000, and further, plaintiff, LAWRENCE MOREAU, is entitled to judgment against defendant PayStation America, Inc., successor-in-interest to DIRECT EXPRESS, LLC, in the additional sum of \$210,000.

Further, pursuant to the orders of Court, after granting defendants' motion for Judgment of Nonsuit as to the fourth and fifth causes of action of the complaint and granting plaintiff's motion for Judgment of Nonsuit as to the first cause of action of the cross-complaint of PayStation America, it is therefore ordered that the fourth and fifth causes of action of the complaint and the first cause of action of the cross-complaint of PayStation America are dismissed.

It is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that plaintiff, LAWRENCE MOREAU, shall have and recover from defendants LOUIS J. KROUSE and PayStation America, Inc., successor-in-interest to DIRECT EXPRESS, LLC, jointly and severally, the sum of \$500,000, and further shall have and recover from defendant PayStation America, Inc., successor-in-interest to DIRECT EXPRESS, LLC, the sum of \$210,000
