ASSIGNMENT OF PATENT RIGHTS

We, ROGER BOSTELMAN, residing in Frederick, Maryland, and JAMES ALBUS, residing in Kensington, Maryland, have invented "SUSPENDED DRY DOCK PLATFORM", and have filed an application for United States Letters Patent, Serial Number 09/968,882 on October 3, 2001.

The invention was made while we were employees of the United States Department of Commerce and under such circumstances that applicable laws and regulations render the patent rights assignable to the United States. The United States of America, represented by the Secretary of Commerce, wishes to acquire these rights.

Therefore, we assign to the United States of America, as represented by the Secretary of Commerce, our full and exclusive world-wide rights to this invention.
