AND, the Commissioner of Patents is requested to issue any Letters Patent of the United States which may be issued for said divisional application and its improvements to **Jürgen Hans SCHENK**, his legal representatives, successors, or assigns, as the sole owner of the entire right, title and interest in and to said patent and the invention covered thereby.
