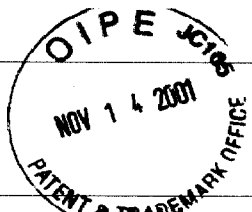

for which we have filed an application for Letters Patent of the United States on July 24, 2001, Application Serial No. 09/912,179;




