WHEREAS the Regents of the University of California, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of California, having its statewide administrative offices located at 1111 Franklin Street, 12th Floor, Oakland, CA 94612-5200 (hereinafter "The Regents") is the owner by assignment from Oded Gottesman of all rights, titles and interests in and to an invention of Oded Gottesman entitled: "Enhanced Waveform Interpolative Coder" (hereinafter "Invention"), which is found in Patent Cooperation Treaty International Application No. PCT/US99/28449 having an international filing date of December 1, 1999 and a priority date of December 1, 1998, and which listed as designated States, inter alia, the United States of America, China, Japan, and Korea (hereinafter "International Patent Application"); and

WHEREAS The Regents has agreed to assign the foreign rights to the Invention to Oded Gottesman or his designee and Oded Gottesman has designated Compandent, Inc., a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of California, having an office at 791 Laurel Walk, Suite D, Santa Barbara, California 93117 (hereinafter "Compandent") to receive said foreign rights, and pursuant thereto has arranged for patent applications to be filed in China, Japan and South Korea and intends to file a regional patent application in the European Patent Office, as national applications from the International Patent Application.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, The Regents hereby sells, assigns and transfers to Compandent all of its foreign rights, titles and interest in and to the Invention and International Patent Application, only for countries foreign to the United States, including without limitation, for Europe, China, Japan and South Korea, The Regents reserving to itself all rights, titles and interests in and to the Invention and International Patent Application for the

United States and its territorial possessions, and in and to all United States Letters Patent to be obtained for said Invention in United States and its territorial possessions by the International Patent Application, any national application filed in the United States of America from the International Patent Application and any continuation, division, or substitute thereof, and any reissue, reexamination or extension of said United States Letters Patent thereon.
