- (c) authorize and request the Commissioner of Patent and Trademarks and any appropriate foreign patent officials to issue any patent which may be granted therefor to Assignee, of the entire right, title, and interest in and to the same, for its sole use and benefit; and for the use and benefit of its legal representatives, to the full end of the term for which said Patent may be granted, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held by Assignor had this assignment and sale not been made.


