

DESIGN PATENT ASSIGNMENT

Parties. This assignment is made by joint inventors Bart Proot and Clemens Van Himbeeck, of Moerestraat 29/1, B-8680 Koekelare, Belgium, and St. Sauveurstraat 104-101, B-9600 Ronse, Belgium, respectively, herein referred to as "inventors," to Samsonite Corporation, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Delaware, of 11200 East 45th Avenue, Denver, Colorado 80239, U.S.A., herein referred to as "assignee."

Background. Inventors have invented a D-Ring Attachment for a Luggage Case, for which they have made application for Letters Patent of the United States under Application No. 29/124026, the invention being described in and identified as Docket No. P67310 in the Legal Department of Samsonite Corporation, 11200 East 45th Avenue, Denver, Colorado 80239.

Inventors now own the entire right, title, and interest therein.

Assignee is desirous of acquiring the entire right, title, and interest in said design, invention, and improvements thereon, and in said application, and letters patent, copyrights, and similar property rights therefor, when granted in the United States and foreign countries.

Assignment. Inventors hereby authorize and request the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks to issue said Letters Patent of the United States of America to assignee, consistent with the terms of this agreement.

Authorization. Inventors hereby authorize assignee to file applications for, to obtain, and to maintain, any patent(s) which assignee may elect to seek in any country or jurisdiction of the world.

The patent rights assigned are to be held by assignee to the full end of the Term. term for which the Letters Patent are granted, and for the term or terms of any extension thereof. as fully as the same would have been held by inventors if this assignment had not been made.

The terms, covenants, and conditions of the assignment shall inure Successors. to the benefit of assignee, its successors, assigns and/or other legal representatives, and shall be binding on inventors, their respective heirs, legal representatives, and assigns.
