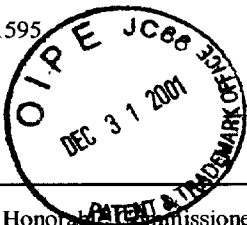

ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, the UNIVERSITY OF FLORIDA, duly organized under and pursuant to the laws of Florida and having its principal place of business at 223 Grinter Hall, Gainesville, Florida 32611-5500, US, is the sole and exclusive owner (hereinafter referred to as the "ASSIGNOR") of BRAIN-ENHANCED DELIVERY OF NEUROACTIVE PEPTIDES BY SEQUENTIAL METABOLISM set forth in the following United States patent:

(filed as United States Application No. 08/428,488 on April 27, 1995)

together with the applications and patents listed in the appendix hereto;

WHEREAS, Nicholas S. Bodor, an individual residing at 10101 Collins Avenue, No. 4A, Bell Harbor, Florida 33154, US, (hereinafter referred to as the "ASSIGNEE"), is desirous of acquiring the title, rights, benefits, privileges, and interest in any and all Letters Patent or Patents, United States, foreign, convention, obtained therefor and thereon;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration furnished by ASSIGNEE to ASSIGNOR, receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, ASSIGNOR hereby, without reservations:

1 . Assigns, transfers, and conveys to ASSIGNEE the entire right, title, and interest in and to said inventions and discoveries, said applications for Letters Patent, any and all other applications for Letters Patent on said inventions and discoveries in whatsoever countries, including all divisional, renewal, substitute, continuation, continuation-in-part, continued prosecution applications, and convention applications based in whole, or in part, upon said inventions or discoveries, or upon said applications, and any and all Letters Patents, reissues, and extensions of Letters Patent granted for said inventions and discoveries or upon said applications, in whatsoever countries, and every priority right that is or may be predicated

upon, or arise from, said inventions, said discoveries, said applications, and said Letters Patent;

2. Authorizes ASSIGNEE to file patent applications in any or all countries on any or all of said inventions and discoveries in ASSIGNOR's name or in the name of ASSIGNEE or otherwise as ASSIGNEE may deem advisable, under International Conventions or otherwise;

3. Authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks of the United States of America and the empowered officials of all other governments throughout the world to issue or transfer all said Letters Patents to ASSIGNEE, as assignee of the entire right, title, and interest therein or otherwise as ASSIGNEE may direct;


4. Warrants that ASSIGNOR has not knowingly conveyed to others any right in said inventions, discoveries, applications, or patents, or any license to use the same, or to make, use, or sell anything embodying or utilizing any of said inventions or discoveries; and that ASSIGNOR has good right to assign the same to ASSIGNEE without encumbrance;

5. Binds ASSIGNOR's heirs, legal representatives, and assigns, as well as ASSIGNOR, to do, upon ASSIGNEE's request and at ASSIGNEE's expense, but without additional consideration to ASSIGNOR or its heirs, legal representatives, or assigns, all acts reasonably serving to assure that said inventions and discoveries, said patent applications, and said Letters Patents shall be held and enjoyed by ASSIGNEE as fully and entirely as the same could have been held and enjoyed by ASSIGNOR, its heirs, legal representatives, and assigns if this Assignment had not been made; and particularly to execute and deliver to ASSIGNEE all lawful application documents including petitions, specifications, and oaths, and all assignments, disclaimers, and lawful affidavits in form and substance as may be requested by ASSIGNEE; and to communicate to ASSIGNEE all facts known to ASSIGNOR relating to said inventions and discoveries or the history thereof, and to testify as to the same in any court or

proceeding; and to furnish ASSIGNEE any and all documents, photographs, models, samples, and other physical exhibits in ASSIGNOR's control or in the control of its heirs, legal representatives, or assigns which may be useful for establishing the facts of conceptions, disclosures, and reduction to practice of said inventions and discoveries.

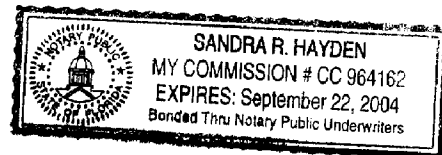
