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## **ASSIGNMENT OF PATENT RIGHTS**

I, Daniel C. Law have invented a "Hexagonal-Annulus Phased Array Antenna for Radar Wind Profiling on Moving Platforms" and have filed an application for United States Letters Patent on February 12, 2001, Serial No. 09/781,768. Under applicable law and government regulations, my rights in the invention are required to be assigned to the United States of America because of the circumstances under which the invention was made.

I warrant that there are no outstanding assignments, grants, liens, encumbrances, or agreements, oral, written, or implied, that will impair the interests conveyed in this assignment at the time I execute this instrument.
