

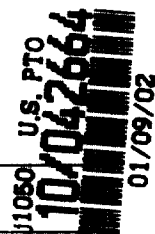

The Assignors, (1) **John M. Heberger**, a United States Citizen residing at 938 River Road, Greer, South Carolina, and (2) **Kenneth J. Muschelewicz**, a United States Citizen residing at 399 Chinquapin Road, Easley, South Carolina, have invented certain new and useful improvements in

SILICONE COATED FILM WITH BACK SIDE SLIP CONTROL COATING AND METHOD OF CONTROLLING SLIP OF SUCH FILM

an invention which is fully described in a continuation-in-part application for Letters Patent of the United States executed by them concurrently herewith,

The Assignors further agree, for themselves and their legal representatives, they will assist Assignee in the prosecution before the United States Patent Office and the Federal Courts of this application, and other applications for Letters Patent including renewals, continuations, divisions, reissues and substitutions, that the Assignee elects to make covering the invention. The Assignors vest in Assignee like exclusive title in and to all such other applications and Letters Patent. The Assignors will execute and deliver to Assignee any documents which may be requested by Assignee to carry out the terms of this Assignment.

The Assignors covenant not to have executed and not to execute any agreement in conflict with this assignment.

The Commissioner of Patents of the United States is authorized and requested to issue Letters Patent of the United States to Assignee. The Assignors also authorize and request the equivalent authorities in foreign countries to issue the patents of foreign countries to Assignee.
