

ASSIGNMENT


WHEREAS, Audi AG, a corporation duly authorized and existing under the laws of Germany, having its principal place of business in Ingolstadt, Germany; and Temic Telefunken Microelectronic GmbH, a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of Germany having its principal place of business in Heilbronn, Germany, hereinafter sometimes collectively referred to as the Assignees, are desirous of acquiring an interest therein.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of Ten Dollars (U.S. \$10.00), in currency of United States of America, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the Assignors, by these presents, do hereby sell, assign and transfer seventy percent (70%) unto said Audi AG and thirty percent (30%) unto said Temic Telefunken microelectronic GmbH, of their entire right, title and interest, for the United States of America and its possession and territories, in and to said invention as described and claimed in an application for letters patent of the United States of America, duly executed by Karl Barnreiter on the 24 day of June, 1998; Hans-Peter Fleischmann, on the 25 day of June, 1998; Johann Märkl, on the 23 day of June, 1998; Hans-Jürgen Rudolph, on the 24 day of June, 1998; Michael Genzel, on the 30 day of June, 1998; Roger Pohlmann, on the 1 day of July, 1998; Armin Gottschaller, on the 1 day of July, 1998; Thomas Schmid, on the 1 day of July, 1998; and Werner Flierl, on the 1 day of July, 1998, preparatory to obtaining letters patent of the United States of America therefor, said application for letters patent of the United States of America, and any continuations, continuations-in-part, divisions, reissues, extensions and renewals thereof, and in and to any letters patents that may be granted for said invention or any other invention disclosed in said application; said inventions, applications for patents and letter patents, and any continuations, continuations-in-part, divisions, reissues, extensions and renewals thereof, to be held and enjoyed by said Assignors as their interests may appear for their own use and behoof and for their legal representatives, successors and assigns, to the full ends of the terms for which


said letters patents may be granted, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held by said Assignors had this assignment and sale not been made.




