WHEREAS, ASSIGNOR is the current, sole and record owner of the registered Intellectual Property set forth on Schedule A, attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, SHEPHERD CASTER CORPORATION ("ASSIGNEE"), a Delaware corporation having its principal place of business in St. Joseph, Michigan, desires to acquire all right, title and interest in and to the Intellectual Property.
