PATENT APPLICATION ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, we, Gregory A. Marsh, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at 7651 Hamot Road, Erie, Pennsylvania 16509, Brian L. Walter, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at 3003 Harvest Bend, Erie, PA 16506, Peter L. Valentine, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at 1960 Cook Avenue, Erie, Pennsylvania 16510, Mahesh C. Aggarwal, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at 4241 W. 32nd Street, Erie, Pennsylvania 16506, Robert A. Armbruster, Jr., a citizen of the United States of America, residing at 620 Young Road, #5, Erie, Pennsylvania 16509, and Vinh K. Do, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at 1800 Blake Street, Lower Level, Berkeley, CA 94703, we have invented new and useful improvements in a Temperature Control For Turbocharged Engine for which application is being made for Letters Patent and is further identified by Attorney's Docket 20-DD-2053, and for which a United States Provisional Patent Application was filed on June 20, 2001, serial number 60/299,660.
