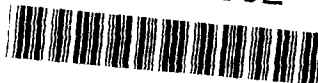

ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, WE, **CHARLES P. NEUNER**, citizen of the United States of America residing at **76 Grand Central Avenue, Amityville, NY 11701** and **HERVE F. BOUIX**, citizen of France residing at **245 East 54th Street, New York, NY 10022**, (hereinafter the ASSIGNORS) are the inventors of the invention in **DISC ARRAY MASCARA APPLICATOR** for which we have executed an application for a Patent of the United States concurrently herewith which is identified by Attorney Docket No. **98.35CIP**; and

WHEREAS, **COLOR ACCESS, INC.**, a Delaware corporation having an office at **7 Corporate Center Drive, Melville, New York 11747**, (hereinafter ASSIGNEE) is desirous of obtaining the entire right, title and interest in, to and under the said invention and the said application:

AND WE HEREBY authorize and request the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks of the United States, and any Official of any country or countries foreign to the United States, whose duty it is to issue patents or other evidence or forms of industrial property protection on applications as aforesaid, to issue the same to the said ASSIGNEE, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, in accordance with the terms of this instrument.

AND WE HEREBY covenant and agree that we have full right to convey the entire interest herein assigned, and that we have not executed, and will not execute, any agreements in conflict herewith.

AND WE HEREBY further covenant and agree that we will communicate to the said ASSIGNEE, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, any facts known to us respecting said invention, and testify in any legal proceeding, sign all lawful papers, execute all divisional, continuing, reissue and foreign applications, make all rightful oaths, and generally do everything possible to aid the said ASSIGNEE, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, to obtain and enforce proper protection for said invention in all countries.
