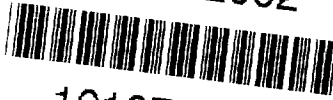


ASSIGNMENT
