CONFIRMATION OF ASSIGNMENT AND ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, JOHN F. GABOWER, a United States citizen, residing at Manitowish, Wisconsin, is the inventor of the Patent entitled "Electromagnetic Interference Shield for Electronic Devices" for which U.S. Patent No. 5,811,050 (the "Patent") was granted on September 22, 1998; and

WHEREAS, in March 2000, the inventor, executed a document entitled Assignment Agreement (the "Assignment"), which document was expressly intended by the inventor to sell, assign, transfer and set over to SHIELDING FOR ELECTRONICS, INC., its successors, legal representatives and assigns, the entire right, title, and interest throughout the world in, to and under the Patent, including, but not limited to, all improvements, and all divisions, renewals and continuations thereof, and all reissues and extensions thereof, and all rights of priority under international conventions and applications for patents which may be filed for the improvements in any country or countries foreign to the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, SHIELDING FOR ELECTRONICS, INC. (hereinafter "ASSIGNEE"), a Delaware Corporation, with its principal place of business at 536 Dartmouth Avenue, San Carlos, CA 94070, desires to confirm its acquisition of the entire right, title, and interest in and to such Patent;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, John F. Gabower, the inventor, does hereby state, covenant, and agree as follows:

1. I confirm that by executing the Assignment I sold, assigned, transferred and set over to the ASSIGNEE, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, the entire right, title, and interest throughout the world in, to and under the Patent and to and under all divisions, renewals, improvements, and continuations of the Patent, and all patents of the United States of America which may be granted thereon and all reissues, reexaminations, and extensions thereof, and all rights of priority under international conventions and applications for patents which could and may be filed for said improvements after the date of the Assignment in any country or countries foreign to the United States of America, and all extensions, renewals and reissues thereof; and I authorized and requested the Commissioner of Patents of the United States of America, and any Official of any country or countries foreign to the United States of America, whose duty is to issue patents on applications as aforesaid, to issue all patents for said improvements to said ASSIGNEE, its successors, legal representatives, and assigns.

2. I confirm that by executing the Assignment I agreed to communicate to the ASSIGNEE, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, any facts known to me respecting the Patent and any and all improvements thereto, and testify in any legal proceeding, sign all lawful papers, execute all divisional, continuing and reissue applications, make all rightful oaths and generally do everything possible to aid the ASSIGNEE, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, to obtain and enforce proper patent protection for said Patent and improvements in all countries.

3. After the date of the Assignment, I have not sold, assigned, transferred, set over or otherwise encumbered the entire right, title and interest to and under said improvements and the

Patent, or any portion of such entire right, title and interest, to any third party.

4. I do hereby sell, assign, transfer and set over, unto the ASSIGNEE, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, the entirety of whatever right, title, and interest I may have throughout the world in, to and under the Patent and all improvements, and all divisions, renewals, and continuations of the patent application which resulted in the Patent and all patents of the United States of America which may be granted thereon and all reissues and extensions thereof, and all rights of priority under international conventions and applications for patents which may be filed for said improvements in any country or countries foreign to the United States of America, and all patents which may be granted for said improvements in any country or countries foreign to the United States of America and all extensions, renewals and reissues thereof, and I hereby authorize and request the Commissioner of Patents of the United States of America, and any official of any country or countries foreign to the United States of America, whose duty it is to issue patents on applications as aforesaid, to issue all patents for any and all such improvements to the ASSIGNEE, its successors, legal representatives and assigns in accordance with the terms of the Assignment and this instrument.

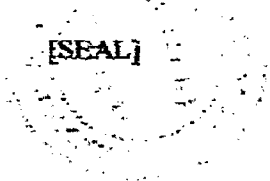
