

Aisenberg (Registration Nos. 20,851, 22,769, 26,421, 29,851, and 19,007, respectively) the power to insert on this Assignment any further identification which may be necessary or desirable in order to identify the related application, or otherwise comply with the rules of the United States Patent and Trademark Office, for recordation of this document.
