WHEREAS, as to foreign rights, the Government desires an option to obtain such rights;





WHEREAS, as to foreign rights, the Government of the United States of America desires to obtain such rights;


NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and other good and valuable consideration the receipt of
