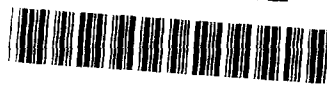


ASSIGNMENT


