#### **EXECUTION**

#### SECURITY AGREEMENT (PATENTS)

This SECURITY AGREEMENT (PATENTS)(this "<u>Agreement</u>") is made as of December 21, 2001, by and between STARENSIER, INC., a Delaware corporation (the "<u>Borrower</u>") and CITIZENS BANK OF MASSACHUSETTS, a Massachusetts bank (the "<u>Lender</u>").
