WHEREAS, Dao Hinh Nguyen, Stewart Berry, David L. And Assignors do hereby request and authorize the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks, U.S.A., to issue said U.S. LETTERS PATENT, when granted, in accordance with this assignment.






