PATENT ASSIGNMENT


For good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, and intending to be legally bound, Julie S. Greenstein, an individual resident at 5833 11<sup>th</sup> Street North, Arlington, Virginia ("GREENSTEIN"), hereby sells, assigns, transfers and sets over to QP6, Inc. ("QP6"), a Virginia corporation with its offices at 5833 11<sup>th</sup> Street North, Arlington, Virginia 22205, the entire right, title and interest in, to and under the patents, patent applications and inventions set forth in Exhibit A, including the right to recover damages and profits that have arisen from infringement of such patents, patent applications and inventions, with the same to be held and enjoyed by QP6 for its use and enjoyment, and for the use and enjoyment of its successors, assigns and legal representatives, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by GREENSTEIN if this assignment had not been made;

GREENSTEIN hereby authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks or other authority responsible for effectuating and/or recording assignments in the country involved, to indicate in its records that QP6 is the assignee of the entire right, title and interest in, to and under the patents and patent applications set forth in the attached Exhibit A as well as in, to and under the inventions disclosed and claimed in said patents and patent applications;

GREENSTEIN agrees to execute whatever further documents are deemed necessary or desirable by QP6, its successors, assigns or legal representatives to record transfer of ownership of said patents, patent applications and inventions from GREENSTEIN to QP6, all at the expense of QP6 or its successors, assigns or legal representatives; and

GREENSTEIN hereby appoints and constitutes QP6, and each officer thereof, its true and lawful attorney, with full power of substitution and with full power and authority to effectuate the transfer of rights hereunder. GREENSTEIN further agrees that it will, at any time, upon request by QP6, its successors, assigns or legal representatives, deliver any and all papers that may be necessary or desirable to perfect the title to said patents, patent applications and inventions or to enable QP6 or its successors, assigns or legal representatives to obtain and enforce protection for said patents, patent applications and inventions.
