assignees, their successors and assigns, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by us if this assignment and sale had not been made.

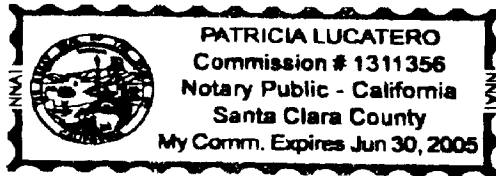
