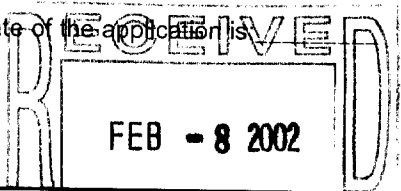

CELL AND TISSUE CULTURE MODELING DEVICE AND APPARATUS AND METHOD OF USING SAME




