WHEREAS DRESSER EQUIPMENT GROUP, INC. did change its name to DRESSER, INC., effective as of March 28, 2001 by certificate of name change recorded with the Delaware Secretary of State;

WHEREAS, DRESSER, INC. (formerly known as DRESSER EQUIPMENT GROUP, INC.) a corporation of the State of Delaware, (hereinafter "ASSIGNEE"), having its principal offices at 11th Floor, Millennium 1, 15455 Dallas Parkway, Addison, Texas 75001, did acquire said PATENTS therefore as a result of a the aforementioned transfer of assets from DRESSER INDUSTRIES, INC. to DRESSER EQUIPMENT GROUP, INC., and is desirous of acquiring all right, title, and interest of the Assignor in and to said PATENTS, effective as of January 31, 1999;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the payment by ASSIGNEE to ASSIGNOR of the sum of One Dollar (\$1), and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, ASSIGNOR does hereby sell, transfer, and assign **NUNC PRO TUNC** unto the said ASSIGNEE, its successors, assigns and other legal representatives, for the territory of the United States of America and throughout the world, the entire right, title and interest in and to the said PATENTS, together with any and all reissues, reexaminations, statutory invention

registrations, modifications and extensions thereof, together with any and all continuations, divisions, continuations-in-part and reissues, and all of the inventions relating to the foregoing, and including all rights to claim priority, and hereby authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents for the country involved to issue any and all patents on inventions resulting from the PATENTS or other applications to ASSIGNEE as ASSIGNEE of the entire right, title and interest therein, all of the foregoing to be held and enjoyed by ASSIGNEE for its own use and for the use of its successors, assigns or other legal representatives, together with all of the income, royalties, damages and payments now or hereafter due or payable with respect thereto, and all claims for damages by reason of past, present and future infringement of the rights assigned under this ASSIGNMENT with the right to sue for and collect the same for its own use and benefit, and for the use and benefit of its successors, assigns and other legal representatives, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by ASSIGNOR if this transfer to ASSIGNEE had not been made.

ASSIGNOR covenants that it will, when requested and at its expense, execute, deliver and acknowledge all such further instruments of conveyance and do and perform all such other acts and things as ASSIGNEE may reasonably require to more effectively accomplish the assignment, transfer and recordation thereof of said PATENTS.

ASSIGNEE's authority hereunder shall include, without limitation, the authority to execute and receive any certificate of ownership or other document to transfer title to any PATENTS rights assigned pursuant to this ASSIGNMENT, and to take any other actions necessary or incident to the powers granted to ASSIGNEE in this ASSIGNMENT.

This Agreement shall inure to the benefit of ASSIGNEE and its successors and assigns and shall be binding on ASSIGNOR and its successors and assigns.

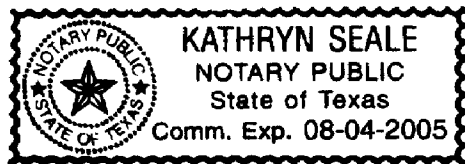



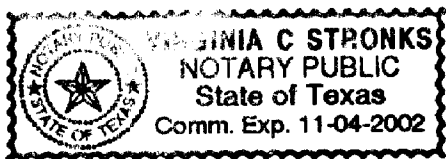
