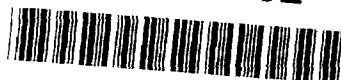


## ASSIGNMENT




