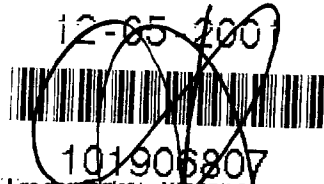

# ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, We, John J. Kilper and Michael J. Leary, citizens of the United States, residents of St. Charles County, State of Missouri, whose post office addresses are 215 Briar Valley Ct., St. Charles, MO 63304 and 146 Rockaway Drive, O'Fallon, MO 63366, respectively, have invented certain improvements in IMPROVED ACCUMULATION CONVEYOR for which we are about to make, and have this day executed, application for Letters Patent of the United States, identified as Attorney's Docket No. ALVY 7552US;
