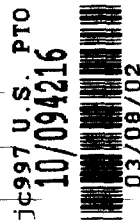

ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, we, Lawrence P. Zepp and Jerry W. Medlin, residing at 2812 Trent Drive, Fort Wayne, Indiana 46815 and 118 Elliotwood Place, Fort Wayne, Indiana 46804, respectively, have invented certain improvements in:

BRUSHLESS PERMANENT MAGNET MOTOR OR ALTERNATOR WITH VARIABLE AXIAL ROTOR/STATOR ALIGNMENT TO INCREASE SPEED CAPABILITY

Medlin, do hereby assign, sell, transfer and set over unto said Dura-Trac Motors, Inc., its successors and assigns, the full, entire and exclusive right, title and interest, for the territory of the United States of America and for all foreign countries, in and to said invention, as described in the application identified above, and in and to said application and any divisions or continuations or continuations-in-part thereof or substitutes therefor which may be filed, and in and to any patents or reissues, renewals or extensions thereof which may be granted on said application or for said invention, and in and to any patent application which may be filed on said invention in countries foreign to the United States of America and any patents granted thereon; said invention, applications, and patents to be held and enjoyed by said Dura-Trac Motors, Inc., and its successors or assigns, to the full end of the term or terms for which said patents may be granted, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held by us had this assignment not been made.
