

FIRST AMENDMENT TO AMENDED AND RESTATED COLLATERAL ASSIGNMENT OF PATENTS AND LICENSE BACK AGREEMENT

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO AMENDED AND RESTATED COLLATERAL ASSIGNMENT OF PATENTS AND LICENSE BACK AGREEMENT is made as of December 1, 2001 (the "**Amendment**") between PRESSCO TECHNOLOGY INC., an Ohio corporation having its principal place of business at 29200 Aurora Road, Cleveland, Ohio 44139 (the "**Company**") and KEYBANK NATIONAL ASSOCIATION, a national banking association organized under the laws of the United States of America (the "**Lender**").

RECITALS

A. Lender and the Company are parties to that certain Amended and Restated Collateral Assignment of Patents and License Back Agreement dated as of September 30, 1998 (the "**Patent Assignment**") by and between the Company and Lender.

B. Pursuant to Section 6 of the Patent Assignment, the Company has authorized Lender to modify the Patent Assignment by amending the list of patent rights and patent applications owned by the Company and attached as Exhibit A to the Patent Assignment to identify any new patent rights and patent applications subsequently issued to or for the benefit of the Company.

C. Since the date of the Patent Assignment, the Company has obtained certain additional rights to patents, patent applications and/or reissues, divisions, continuations, renewals, extensions or continuations-in-part of patents and patent applications.

D. Lender and the Company now desire to amend the Patent Assignment to specifically identify the Company's newly acquired patents and patent rights as part of the Collateral securing the Obligations owing to Lender. Unless otherwise defined herein, all capitalized terms used in this Amendment will have the meanings given to them in the Patent Assignment.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing premises, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and adequacy of which are hereby acknowledged, the Company hereby covenants, represents, and agrees with Lender as follows:

AGREEMENT

1. Additional Collateral Description. The Company acknowledges and agrees that the Collateral includes, without limitation, the patent rights and patent applications set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, which exhibit shall supplement the original exhibit attached to the Patent Assignment. In accordance with the terms of the Patent Assignment, the Company hereby grants, assigns, transfers and sets over to Lender its entire right, title and interest in and to all of the property and interests identified in Exhibit A attached hereto, together with all cash and non-cash proceeds thereof, all reissues, divisions, continuations, renewals, extensions and continuations-in-part thereof, and all other rights and interests of the Company corresponding thereto throughout the world.

2. Delivery and Recordation of Cover Sheet. Within 30 days after executing this Amendment, the Company shall deliver to Lender (i) a completed Recordation Form Cover Sheet for filing with the United States Patent Office identifying all existing Patents and Patent Applications subject to the Patent Assignment, as amended by this Amendment, currently on file with the United States Patent Office, and (ii) an opinion of the Company's patent counsel, in form and content acceptable to Lender, certifying that upon filing of the foregoing Recordation Form Cover Sheet and this Amendment, Lender will have a validly perfected first-priority security interest in the patents and patent applications identified in the Recordation Form Cover Sheet and Exhibit A attached hereto (excluding those patent applications for which no serial number has been issued yet, it being understood that the Company shall notify Lender when serial numbers are issued for such patent applications in accordance with Section 6 of the Patent Assignment).

3. Representations and Warranties. The Company represents and warrants to Lender the following:


- a) Exhibit A attached to this Amendment sets forth all the rights to patents and patent applications presently owned, licensed or controlled by the Company; and
- b) As of the date of this Amendment, the representations and warranties contained in the Patent Assignment (other than the representation that Exhibit A attached to the Patent Assignment sets forth all the rights to patents and patent applications owned, licensed or controlled by the Company) remain true and correct in all material respects, and such representations and warranties do not contain any untrue statement of a material fact or omit any material fact necessary to make such representations and warranties not misleading, and all such representations and warranties shall be deemed to be made as of the date of this Amendment and the scope of such representations shall be deemed to include the Company's execution and delivery of this Amendment.

4. Ratification. In all other respects the Patent Assignment shall remain as originally stated. The Company and Lender hereby confirm and ratify each of the provisions of the Patent Assignment as amended herein.


5. Successors and Assigns. The benefits and burdens of this Amendment shall inure to the benefit of and be binding upon the respective successors and permitted assignees of the parties.


