ASSIGNMENT OF INVENTION

WHEREAS, I, Francis John Kolpak, residing in Newark, Delaware, together with Leo Michael Landoll, residing in Hockessin, Delaware, Annette Marie Comer, residing in Covington, Virginia and Michael Gary Fatica, residing in Warwick, Rhode Island, jointly have made a certain new and useful invention in FILM, which is the subject of U.S. Patent No. 6, 139,930.

WHEREAS, I, Francis John Kolpak was an employee of a predecessor-in-interest of Applied Extrusion Technologies, Inc. (hereinafter "AET") at the time that the invention was made, having an obligation to assign the invention and '930 patent to AET.

TO BE HELD AND ENJOYED by the said AET and its legal representatives and assigns to the full ends of the terms for which said Letters Patents, or any of them, have been granted or may be granted as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by me had no sale and assignment of said interest been made; and I hereby agree for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to execute without further consideration, any further legal documents and any further assignments and any releases, reissues, renewals or other application for Letters Patent based upon said U.S. Patent No. 6, 139,930 that may be deemed necessary by AET, fully to secure to AET, its interest as aforesaid in and to said invention or any part thereof, and in and to said U.S. Patent No. 6, 139,930 and any reissues or renewals thereof.
