NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and adequacy of which are hereby acknowledged, ASSIGNOR does hereby sell, assign, convey and transfer to ASSIGNEE all right, title and interest in and to the Patent and the inventions disclosed and claimed therein, and any continuations, continuations-in-part and/or any divisional applications thereof (said applications to be included within the meaning of the term Patent as used herein) and any reissue patents pertaining to any of the Patent, and any reissued Patent, and any re-examination of any of the Patent, the same to be held and enjoyed by ASSIGNEE for its own use and enjoyment and for the use and enjoyment of its successors, assigns, and legal representatives, to the end of the terms for which the Patent, or any of them, which causes of action and claims arose prior to the date of execution hereof, together with the right to sue for and collect the same for ASSIGNEE's own use, benefit and enjoyment, and for the use, benefit and enjoyment of its successors, assigns and legal representatives.

ASSIGNOR hereby agrees that ASSIGNEE shall have the right to record this instrument of assignment in the United States Patent and Trademark Office so as to establish ASSIGNEE as owner of record of the Patent and the inventions disclosed and claimed therein in the United States.




