## ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, AVGI Engineering, Inc., a Massachusetts corporation having a place of business at 41 Bullard Ln., Millis, MA 02054 ("ASSIGNOR"), holds United States Letters Patent No. 6,321,585 and all right, title, and interest in and to that certain differential pressure generator, which is the invention described in such Letters Patent; and

WHEREAS, ASSIGNOR has received certain membership interests in ASSIGNEE under that certain Operating Agreement of ASSIGNEE dated as of March 4, 2002, pursuant to which ASSIGNOR is obligated to contribute all right, title, and interest of ASSIGNOR and its sole stockholder, George E. Sgourakes ("Sgourakes"), in and to said invention and said Letters Patent in exchange for such membership interests; and

WHEREAS, Vevionics, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company having a place of business at 550 Washington Street, #301, Braintree, Massachusetts 02184 ("ASSIGNEE"), is desirous of acquiring said invention and said Letters Patent; and

WHEREAS, in exchange for the issuance of such membership interests, ASSIGNEE further requires that ASSIGNOR and Sgourakes contribute all of their respective right, title, and interest in and to each design for a differential pressure calibrator or generator that is based on, derived from, or relating to such Letters Patent; each design for a differential pressure cell that is developed by Mr. Sgourakes; each design for a valve developed by Mr. Sgourakes that could be used with either a differential pressure calibrator or differential pressure cell; and all diagrams, drawings, images, computer data, descriptive material, and prototypes related to, based on, or depicting any of the foregoing intellectual properties.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration for the grant of membership interests in ASSIGNEE to ASSIGNOR and other good and valuable executed consideration, the full receipt and sufficiency of all of which are hereby acknowledged, ASSIGNOR and Sgourakes hereby agree to sell, assign, transfer, and convey and by these presents do sell, assign, transfer, and convey unto the above-named ASSIGNEE, their respective whole and entire right, title, and interest in and to:

said invention as described in the above Letters Patent, for the territory of the United States and its possessions and territories and all foreign countries;

the above Letters Patent and any and all United States and foreign Letters Patent that may be granted on said invention including divisions, reissues, and continuations;

each design for a differential pressure calibrator or differential pressure generator developed or to be developed in whole or in part by Mr. Sgourakes that is based on, derived from, or relating to such Letters Patent;

each design for a differential pressure cell that developed or to be developed in whole or in part by Mr. Sgourakes;

each design for a valve developed or to be developed in whole or in part by Mr. Sgourakes that could be used with either a differential pressure calibrator or differential pressure cell;

any Letters Patent and any and all United States and foreign Letters Patent (and any application therefor) that may be granted on any such differential pressure calibrator, differential pressure generator, differential pressure cell, or valve; and

all diagrams, drawings, images, computer data, descriptive material, and prototypes related to, based on, or depicting any of the foregoing intellectual properties;

said invention and Letters Patent to be held and enjoyed by the above-named ASSIGNEE, for ASSIGNEE's own use and behoof, and for ASSIGNEE's legal representatives and assigns to the full end of the term or terms for which said Letters Patent are granted, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held by the undersigned ASSIGNOR had this assignment not been made; and for the aforesaid consideration ASSIGNOR and Sgourakes hereby covenant, agree, and undertake to execute, whenever requested by the above-named ASSIGNEE, all patent applications, assignments, lawful oaths, and any other papers that ASSIGNEE may deem necessary or desirable for securing to ASSIGNEE or for maintaining for ASSIGNEE all the Letters Patent hereby assigned or agreed to be assigned; all without further compensation to the undersigned ASSIGNOR or Sgourakes.
