equivalent to issue the Letters Patent or similar legal protection to the Assignee.



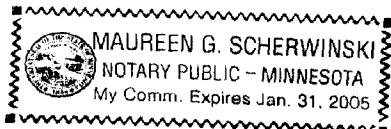
