Delago, have invented certain new and useful improvements in a **RADIAL SUPPORT ASSEMBLY FOR AN APPARATUS FOR POSITIONING A VESSEL**, for which a continuation-in-part application for Letters Patent of the United States was made and which claims continuation-in-part priority to Patent Application Serial No. 339,832, filed November 14, 1994, said continuation-in-part application being identified in the United States Patent Office by Serial No. 644,712 , filed May 10, 1996, issued as Patent No. 5,746,148 on May 5, 1998; and

Upon said consideration I do hereby covenant and agree with the said assignee, its successors and assigns, that I will not execute in writing or do any act whatsoever conflicting with these presents, and that I or my executors or administrators will at any time upon request, without further or additional consideration, but at the expense of the said assignee, its successors and assigns, execute such additional writings and do such additional acts as said assignee, its successors and assigns, may deem necessary or desirable to perfect the assignee's enjoyment of this grant, and render all necessary assistance in making application for and obtaining original, divisional, continuation, re-examined, reissued or extended Letters Patent of the United States, or

of any and all foreign countries on said invention, and in enforcing any rights occurring as a result of such applications or patents, by giving testimony in any proceedings or transactions involving such applications or patents.
