WHEREAS, Westinghouse Electric Corporation changed its name to CBS Corporation on December 1, 1997;


WHEREAS, CBS Corporation merged with ASSIGNOR on May 4, 2000; and

and in any and all foreign countries to be obtained for said patent properties and all divisions, reexaminations, reissues, substitutions, continuations, continuations-in-part, and extensions thereof or any legal equivalent thereof in a foreign country for the full term or terms for which the same may be granted, including all rights of priority, all rights to publish cautionary notices reserving ownerships of said inventions and all rights to file to register said inventions in appropriate registries.
