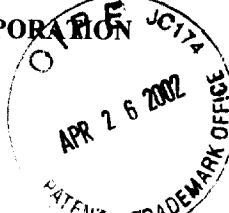

AND, Chiyoda Corporation authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks to issue all such Letters Patents to the said Mitsubishi Chemical Corporation, in accordance with these instruments of assignments.

Chiyoda Corporation, hereby represents and warrants that there are no rights or interests outstanding inconsistent with the rights and interests granted herein, and that Chiyoda Corporation will not execute any instrument or grant or transfer any rights or interests inconsistent therewith, and Chiyoda Corporation

binds itself and its heirs, executors, administrators, employees and legal representatives, as the case may be, to execute and deliver to the said Mitsubishi Chemical Corporation, its successors and assigns, any further documents or instruments and do any and all further acts that may be deemed necessary by the said Mitsubishi Chemical Corporation, its successors and assigns.

AND, Chiyoda Corporation further covenants and agrees, in consideration of the premises, that it, its executors and administrators will, at any time upon request, communicate to the said Mitsubishi Chemical Corporation, its successors and assigns, any facts relating to the said inventions and the history thereof, known to it or its successors and assigns, and that it will testify as to the same in any interference or other proceeding when requested to do so by the said Mitsubishi Chemical Corporation, its successors and assigns.

The undersigned hereby grants the law firm of Birch, Stewart, Kolasch & Birch, LLP the power to insert on these Assignments any further identification which may be necessary or desirable in order to comply with the rules of the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office for recordation of this document.
