WHEREAS, I, Andrew F. Poag of St. Louis, Missouri 63117 have invented an improvement in an ELECTRIC MOTOR COOLING JACKET ASSEMBLY (file E-2213; EMER 2608) and have executed an application for a United States patent based thereon as Serial No. 29/112,504, filed October 18, 1999, which issued on March 19, 2002 as U.S. Patent No. US D454,539 S, and an improvement in an ELECTRIC MOTOR CONNECTOR (file E-2213-C; EMER 2608.1) and have executed an application for a United States patent based thereon as Serial No. 29/147,882, filed September 7, 2001;

AND I hereby authorize and request the Commissioner of Patents of the United States of America to issue any and all United States patents which may be granted upon said United States applications or any of them, or upon said inventions or any part thereof, to said ASSIGNEE;

AND I hereby agree for myself and for my heirs, executors and administrators, to execute without further consideration any further lawful documents and any further assurances, and any provisional, non-provisional, divisional, continuing, reissue, or other applications for patents of any country, that may be deemed necessary by said ASSIGNEE fully to secure to said ASSIGNEE its interest as aforesaid in and to said inventions or any part thereof, and in and to said several patents or any of them;

AND I hereby covenant for myself and my legal representatives, and agree with said ASSIGNEE, its successors and assigns, that I have granted no right or license to make, use or

sell said inventions, to anyone except said ASSIGNEE, that prior to the execution of this deed my right, title, and interest in said inventions had not been otherwise encumbered, and that I have not executed and will not execute any instrument in conflict herewith.
