I covenant that I am the lawful owner of said PCT application, said inventions, and said improvements, that the same are unencumbered, and that I have the full right to make this assignment.

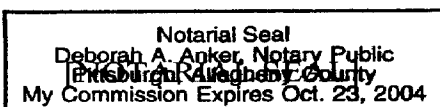
