WHEREAS, I, Bertha K. Madras, residing at 32 Montrose Street, Newton, MA 02458, U.S.A., having invented TROPANE ANALOGS AND METHODS FOR INHIBITION OF MONOAMINE TRANSPORT; and

States to issue such Letters Patent as shall be granted upon said U.S. application(s) to said Assignee, its successors and assigns.
