

## **Change in Finnish Company Names (OY → OYJ)**

The reason for the change in the designations of Finnish limited companies (joint-stock companies) is the Companies Act Amendment (from 1 September 1997) due to which there will be a division of limited companies into public and private companies in Finland:

- 1) **Private company** (minimum capital FIM 50,000)
  - The company name has to contain the word "osakeyhtiö" (Swedish "aktiebolag") or its abbreviation "oy" (Swedish "ab"), closest English equivalents being 'limited company' and 'Ltd.' respectively
- 2) **Public company** (minimum capital FIM 500,000)
  - The company name has to contain the words "julkinen osakeyhtiö" (Swedish "publikt aktiebolag") or the abbreviation "oyj" (Swedish "abp"), closest English equivalents being 'public limited company' and 'PLC' respectively
