ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, DAVID W. GOLDE, a co-inventor of the invention claimed in U.S. Serial No. 08/259,451, now U.S. Patent No. 6,406,841 issued on June 18, 2002, executed an assignment of his entire right, title, and interest for the United States of America and Territories thereof and for all foreign countries and territories, in and to said invention, on September 12, 1994;
